Per Council member Christi Cox's request, this item has been added for consideration. This is a Council initiated rezoning. The property is located in a rural area of the County with nearby parcels either low density residential or undeveloped. Properties to the north, south, and east are currently zoned UD and parcels to the west are zoned RUD. The Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use map shows this area as rural residential.

5. Authorized acceptance of a South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control Grant-in-Aid in the amount of \$18,938.56 with a match of 5.5% that will be achieved through in-kind services.
6. Approved a Law Enforcement Victim Advocate Grant in the amount of \$65,226.
7. Authorized a 16th Judicial Circuit Law Enforcement Network Grant in the amount of \$10,000. No local match is required.
8. Authorized termination of Memorandum of Understanding with Sheriff's Office regarding IT staff.
9. Authorized award of Bid #2368 regarding the purchase of four 2017 model, tandem cabs and chassis 54,000 gvc trucks for use by the Bethany, Bullock Creek, McConnells, and Smyrna Fire Departments, to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, Carolina International Trucks of Greer SC, for a total cost of \$356,377.44.
10. Approved declaring four tactical ballistic vests and four tactical ballistic helmets as County surplus and donate all of the associated equipment AS-IS, to the City of Aiken South Carolina's Department of Public Safety.
11. Authorized an agreement between the Langrum Branch Baptist Church and York County to install and monitor a groundwater monitoring well to conduct groundwater sampling related to the York County Solid Waste Disposal Facility as requested by SC DHEC.
12. Authorized a Venue Agreement with Tender Hearts Ministries for the Utilization of County Properties for the Trunk or Treat event.
13. Authorized a Venue Agreement with We Care Car Show for the utilization of County properties for staging of a car show and related activities.
14. Authorized a Venue Agreement with the York American Legion for the Utilization of County Properties for the Staging of Its Veterans Day Parade with the amendment of removing the liability and insurance requirement and the County sponsor this as a County event.

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15. APPROVED BY TITLE ONLY AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE EXISTING AGREEMENT GOVERNING THE YORK-CHESTER INDUSTRIAL PARK TO ADD PROPERTIES WITHIN THE GEOGRAPHICAL BOUNDARIES OF YORK COUNTY TO THE MULTICOUNTY PARK; TO CORRECT AND UPDATE COMPANY NAMES ASSOCIATED WITH CERTAIN PARCELS INCLUDED IN THE PARK; TO CORRECT AND UPDATE TAX MAP NUMBERS ASSOCIATED WITH CERTAIN PARCELS INCLUDED IN THE PARK; TO REMOVE PROPERTIES LOCATED WITHIN THE GEOGRAPHICAL BOUNDARIES OF YORK COUNTY THAT NO LONGER QUALIFY FOR INCLUSION IN THE MULTICOUNTY PARK; TO PROVIDE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING; AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO.
