

Roadways in York County



- ▣ 2,300 miles of roadway in York County
 - Cities & Towns, County, and State

- ▣ 60% are maintained by SCDOT


- ▣ Local SCDOT office maintains 6,285 miles
 - Oversees 7 Counties
 - More roadway miles than 12 states in the United States.

- ▣ South Carolina has the 4th largest roadway system
 - Also maintains the 4th lowest gas tax for roadway funding

C-fund Gasoline Tax Program

- ▣ Funding is apportioned monthly from the gasoline tax to York County from the total amount of C-funds available in the State:
 - 1/3 based on the ratio of land area of York County to land area of the state of South Carolina
 - 1/3 based on the ratio of county population as determined by the latest 10-year census
 - 1/3 based on the ratio of rural road mileage in York County to rural road mileage in the state.
- ▣ State law requires that 25% of all C-fund money be assigned to State-maintained roads or projects
- ▣ York County sets aside an additional 15% for Economic Development



Chip Seal on Gravel Roads



BEFORE

- Average cost to pave a gravel road:
\$85 per linear foot
\$450,000 per mile
- Average cost to chip seal a gravel road:
\$35 per linear foot
\$185,000 per mile
- Savings of \$50 per foot or
\$265,000 per mile
