



# SET UP MOVED HOUSE

## NPDES QUESTIONNAIRE

### SURVEY OF PROPERTY

- Depending on the location of your property and your request, you may be required to submit a property survey along with your application. If you have a copy please bring it with you. If you do not have a copy one may be obtained from the York County Clerk of Court's office in York.

**\* If property is adjacent to Lake Wylie/Catawba River Buffer a Lake Wylie/Catawba River Survey will need to be provided.**

### ZONING COMPLIANCE PERMIT

- This can be obtained by submitting the plat and property tax map number to the Zoning Department for approval. **There will be a fifty dollar (\$50.00) fee that will be included in the price of your building permit.**

The following information may affect the issuance of a zoning compliance:

1. Zoning classification;
2. Number of dwellings on property;
3. Location of proposed home in relationship to the road right-of-way; property lines and other structures;
4. If property is being divided, we must have a stamped approved copy from the York County Subdivision Administrator with the Clerk of Court recorded stamp.

### SEPTIC TANK PERMIT / PROOF OF SEPTIC (LETTER FROM DHEC)

- This letter can be obtained from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC). Their telephone number is (803) 909-7379. Public or community systems must have written approval from DHEC and the Governing Authority.

**Note: A zoning compliance is necessary prior to applying for a septic tank permit from DHEC  
If property is located in municipality you will need, proof of tap fees being paid.**

### BLUE PRINTS

- You will not need a set of blue prints; however, you must provide accurate information as to the square footage of the house, including all decks and porches.

**In addition, all new work must meet current Building and Code requirements**

**A permit can only be obtained by the property owner or a South Carolina licensed contractor.**

**If you are not the property owner, documentation will be required from the property owner.**
