



### **York County Creates a Local Contractor Program**

**York, SC-** On Nov. 7, 2016, County Council adopted a resolution to endorse the establishment of a local subcontracting initiative as a part of the capital improvements program. York County seeks to encourage general contractors to consider local sub-contractors, within purchasing guidelines, for work on the County's capital projects. Thus, creating local jobs and putting money back into the local economy.

Therefore, York County has created an online local subcontractor registry to recruit and encourage subcontractor participation within the York County capital improvements program. This online registry will serve as a tool to assist in providing local subcontractors an opportunity to bid on work for county capital projects. Vendors can register to be placed on the sub-contractor registry by visiting the front page section of the York County website page called *County Focus* or at the following address: <http://localsubcontractorlisting.yorkcountygov.com/>.

Additionally, York County staff is hosting a meeting for sub-contractors to learn how to do business with York County, provide an overview of the capital projects and to explain the new subcontractor registry. Details of this meeting are as follows:
