Camping Rules & Regulations:

- ENFORCEMENT: Park Rangers have the authority to enforce all Park Regulations and assign campsites. Failure to abide by Park Rules can lead to temporary or permanent exclusion or prosecution.
- Golf Cart operators must possess a valid driver's license with no restrictions.
- Campers are allowed either a maximum of one trailer/RV and one tent, or two tents per site.
- No more than six persons (or one family) may occupy the same site.
- Check in at 2:00 pm
- Check out at 12:00 pm
- Site change must be approved by park staff.
- Maximum length of stay on a particular site is 14 nights. Please see Park Staff for rules on extended stay.

- Cancellations are subject to fees based on the notice given. See website.
 - Senior citizens (age 60 and older) and disabled may register for a campsite at a reduced rate. The qualifying individual must be present for the duration of the stay. Proof of age or disability is required at check in.
 - No storage of RV's, campers or boat trailers allowed.
 - Campers must be at least 21 years of age to register a campsite, and must be present during duration of stay.
 - Quiet Hours: 10:00 pm - 7:00 am Strictly Enforced.
 - Fireworks are prohibited.
 - All fires must be confined to designated grills or fire rings. Moving of fire rings is prohibited.

Pet Rules: Pets must be on a leash or other physical restraint at all times. Owners will be asked to remove noisy or dangerous pets or pets that threaten or harass wildlife. Pets are not allowed in

swimming area or building facilities. Pet owners are responsible for any damage caused by pet. For your convenience pet stations are located throughout the park for disposing of pet refuse.

Unlawful Acts include (but are not limited to) the following:

- Destroying, defacing, disturbing or removing any part of any building, sign, structure or equipment.
- Destroying, cutting, breaking, removing, defacing, mutilating, injuring, taking or gathering any tree, shrub, other plant or plant part, rock, mineral, or geological feature except by permit.
- Dumping any refuse or waste, including grey water, from any trailer or other vehicle except in places or receptacles provide for such use.

- Operating vehicles in a reckless manner, or in excess of posted speed limits, or in areas other than those specifically intended for vehicular traffic.
- Consuming or displaying in public any beverage of alcoholic content, including beer and wine or controlled substance.
- Acting in a disorderly manner or creating any noise which would result in annoyance to others.
- Entering a facility or area without regard to restrictions on public.

- Park is open daily from 6 am to Dark year round.
- After hours boating access is available, see park staff for details.
- Parking Fees assessed Memorial Day Weekend - Labor Day.
- First Aid Kits available at Ranger Station, Gate House & Lifeguard Station.
- Fire Extinguishers located at Ranger Station, Bathhouse, Gate House and Lifeguard Station.
- Wi-Fi available throughout the park, limited connectivity in certain areas.
